For whatever reason, their parents and guardians decided that they had raised them and no longer wished to be their parent(s) or support system.

I still cannot wrap my head around it all, but it's also something we're preparing to deal with as this school year's end is approaching.

We are thankful to say that each boy that we were contacted to help found shelter and later housing. One found an efficiency apartment, three lived in roommate situations, and two found extended community that allowed them to live with them while better preparing them for beginning adulthood.
